R & A Meeting - December 12

Simeon Hart (President), Don Conway (Vice President), and Arne Lundquist (International Relations & Development) will be attending a meeting / workshop with R&A at St Andrews on Friday 12th December 2014. This meeting will focus on:

- Debriefing on R&A support towards the past three World Deaf Golf Championships and presentation of business case towards future WDGCs;
- How R&A can assist towards development of opportunities for deaf and hard of hearing golfers via four main mechanisms:
- Modernisation and enhancing of website to meet current needs;
- Development of promotional video showcasing deaf golf internationally;
- Ensuring access of all videos on R&A website are either captioned and/or provided with a sign interpreter (in International Sign);
- To foster and promote the inclusivity of deaf and hard of hearing golf within the National Golf Organisations of each country, and the provision of pathways and opportunities for these golfers;
- IGF & Deaflympics: Fostering of relationship with IGF, and setting the path towards inclusion of golf in Deaflympics, which has, in principle, the backing of ICSD (International Committee of Sport of the Deaf – which is recognized by the IOC).

We will provide a summary of the outcomes from this meeting, in our Winter Newsletter.

Anders Hillding, our WDFG Technical Director, will liaise with the EDOGC to ensure all rules and procedures are followed thoroughly.
